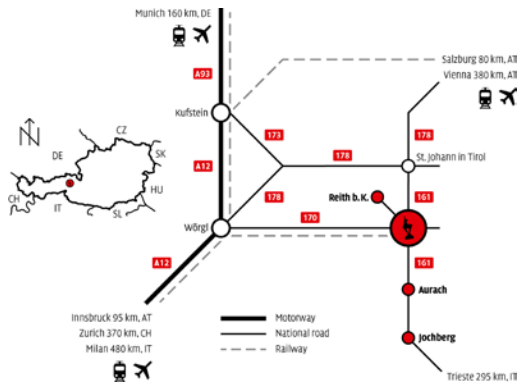

High above the clouds ...

Direct flights from many European countries to Munich, Innsbruck and Salzburg open up a wealth of travel opportunities. Continue by train, bus, Airport Shuttle or rented car to reach Kitzbühel in just 90 minutes!

By train - comfortable, resource-friendly travel from Austria, Germany and Switzerland directly to Kitzbühel ...



From Austria:

Travel directly to Kitzbühel with the Austrian Federal Railways (ÖBB) from Vienna, Linz, Graz and Salzburg. From all other destinations, change at Wörgl, from where the suburban railway takes you to Kitzbühel at 30-minute intervals. Check timetables at www.oebb.at

From Germany:

The Intercity from Munich takes you directly to Kitzbühel in just 1 hour and 50 minutes. The ÖBB Nightjets from Hamburg, Hanover, Düsseldorf and Cologne all stop at Wörgl. From there, take the suburban railway to Kitzbühel. Check timetables at www.bahn.de

From Switzerland:

The Eurocity Transalpin takes you directly from Zurich to Kitzbühel in a panorama carriage! Six other RailJet connections take you to Kitzbühel via Wörgl in just 4 hours and 44 minutes. Check timetables at www.sbb.ch

Travel light - literally! The ÖBB in Austria and Switzerland and the DB in Germany offer a pick-up service for your luggage directly from your house.

NEW Summer 2019 - Wandertaxi Kitzbühel-Südberge
