

Terms and Conditions – 24h Sports Challenge

1. Organiser

The "24h Sports Challenge" is organised by Kitzbühel Tourism (hereinafter referred to as the "Organiser").

2. Participation period

The challenge takes place from 1 September to 30 September, 12 midnight. Participation is only possible within this period.

3. Eligibility

All natural persons aged 18 and over are eligible to participate. Participation is free of charge and independent of the purchase of goods or services.

4. Challenge procedure

- The goal is to engage in as many different sports as possible within 24 hours.
- Each sport must be actively practised for at least 20 minutes.
- In gyms, a maximum of 3 different sports can be counted.
- Each activity must be tracked and clearly documented via a smartwatch or fitness/tracking app (e.g., Strava, Garmin, Apple Health, Komoot, etc.).
- Activities must be recorded as separate sessions and must include information on date, time, duration, and type of sport.

5. Participation and submission

 Participation is completed by: Submitting proof of activities (e.g., link to a Strava profile or upload of screenshots) via the participation form on our landing page: https://www.kitzbuehel.com/en/24h-kitzbuehel-challenge/

6. Publication of activities

- By participating, the participant expressly agrees that:
 - the submitted activity data (tracking links, screenshots, number of sports, duration) as well as
 - o their name or username



- o where applicable, the submitted social media post
 - may be published on the challenge landing page, in social media posts, and in related communications.
- No health-related or sensitive data beyond the type of activities, duration, and tracking visualisation will be published.
- Publication will take place solely within the context of reporting and documenting the challenge.

7. Evaluation and prizes

- The person with the highest number of clearly documented sports within 24 hours wins.
- In the event of a tie, a jury or a random draw will decide.
- Winners will be notified by email or direct message no later than 15 October 2025.

Prizes:

- 1. prize: 2 nights for two people at Das Reisch
- 2. prize: Day spa for two people at Bichlhof
- 3. prize: 3-course hike for two people

Prize for the participant who tags @kitzbuehel_tirol most actively on social media: Day spa for two people at Schlosshotel Kitzbühel.

8. Data protection

Data collection

The following personal data will be collected for participation:

- First and last name or username
- Email address
- Proof of tracking (links, screenshots)
- Social media posts with hashtag

This data will be used exclusively for conducting and managing the challenge.



Data processing and publication

By participating, the participant agrees that the submitted data may be processed and publicly published within the context of the challenge (see point 6).

Retention period

The data will be stored until [e.g., 30 days] after the end of the challenge and will then be deleted, unless a legal obligation to retain it exists.

Rights of participants

Participants have the right at any time to:

- Obtain information about the stored data
- Correct inaccurate data
- Request deletion of their data (where permissible)
- Restrict processing
- Object to processing
